14 year 8 students spent the day at SOAS university for the start of the Brilliant Club. Students were introduced to university life and what they would be doing during their brilliant club sessions.

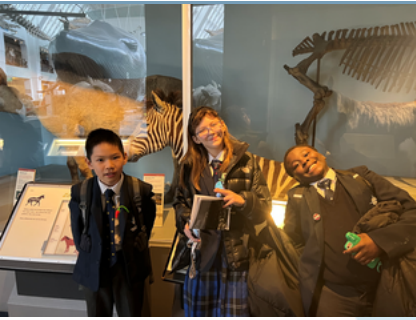
Science trip
