### Recent News

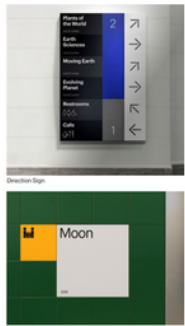
**Oxford Graduates**
